If you would like to make a mini-vacation out of our great Hamfest, consider staying overnight in Goleta, Santa Barbara or Carpinteria. There are nearby motels and inns that should make you comfortable.

For your convenience, here are the closest ones to the Elks Lodge in Goleta, the home of our Hamfest.

South Coast Inn 5620 Calle Real, Goleta 805-967-3200 (practically across the street from the Elks Lodge)

Holiday Inn 5650 Calle Real, Goleta 805-964-6241 (just around the corner from the Elks Lodge and going west)

Motel 6 5897 Calle Real, Goleta 805-964-3596 (around the corner and up the street going west from the Elks Lodge)

If you would like to bring your RV along, consider three locations at California State Beaches along the South Coast.

Refugio State Beach suggested for those coming down the coast

El Capitan State Beach suggested for those coming down the coast

Carpinteria State Beach suggested for those coming up the coast
